I am an experienced hardware service technician, with training and experience at general (help desk) computer support, and competency at (hand) coding web-pages.

As a hardware service technician, I have excellent troubleshooting skills, together with considerable experience at board level and mechanical repair work. This includes extensive experience hand soldering computer circuit boards. My most recent contract IT assignment was at an IBM International call center, where for 21 months I provided “up and running” phone support for desktop PC’s.

After that placement, I worked to train myself at web development; and a year volunteering at reBOOT Canada contributed to my training in two ways. In the service area, a former HP service technician trained me in the basics of laser printer repair. While devoting about half my time to the front office provided some basic experience at general warehouse activities.

I have done light industrial assembly and packing through Adecco– to make it possible to fund my own professional development and certification training. Along with that, volunteering at Free Geek Toronto keeps me working at technical projects while learning Ubuntu and other open source packages.

My living with facial pain that is well controlled, and delayed sleep phase syndrome (I function best from noon until midnight), would qualify me as a disability employee.
